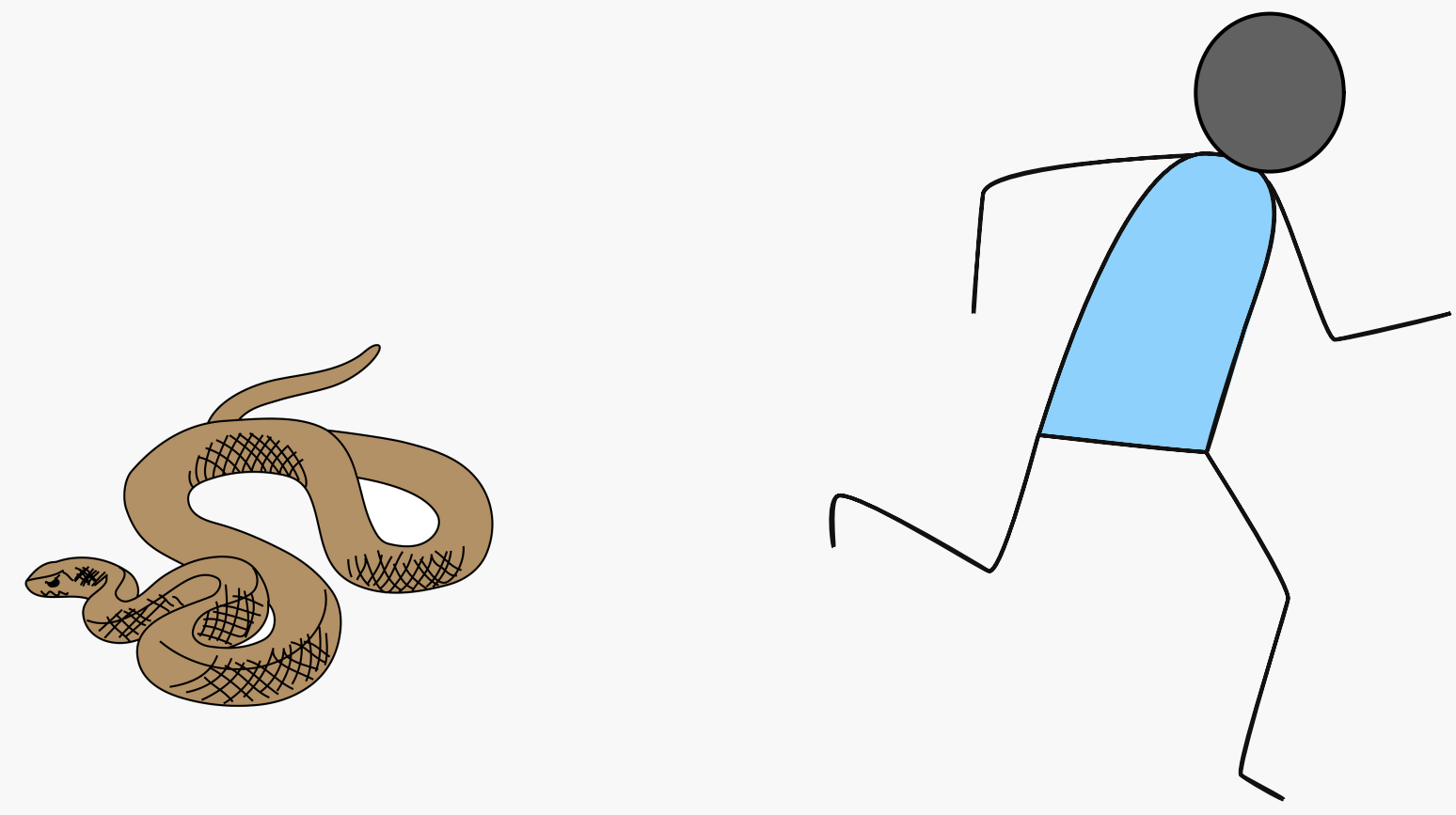
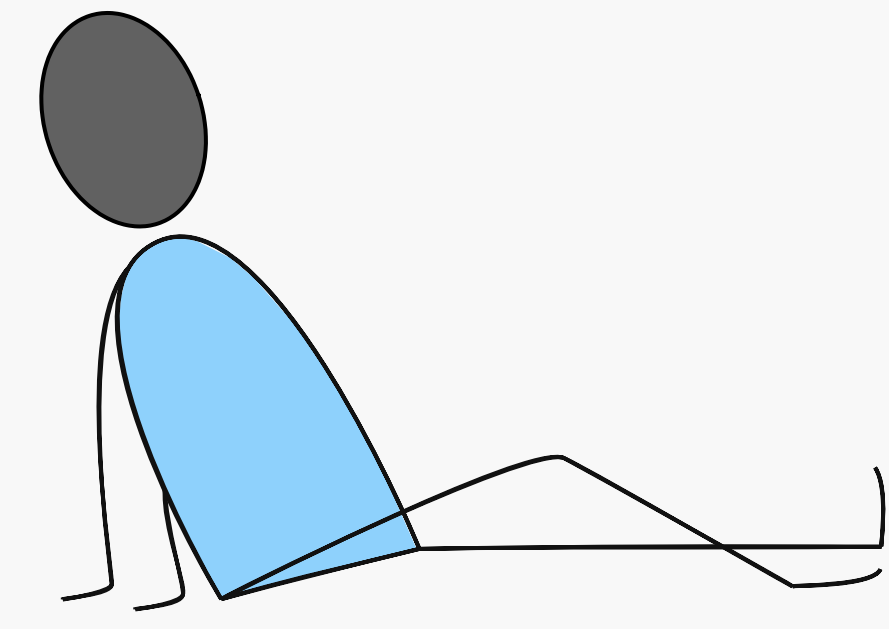


FIRST AID FOR SNAKEBITE: TO DO OR NOT TO DO

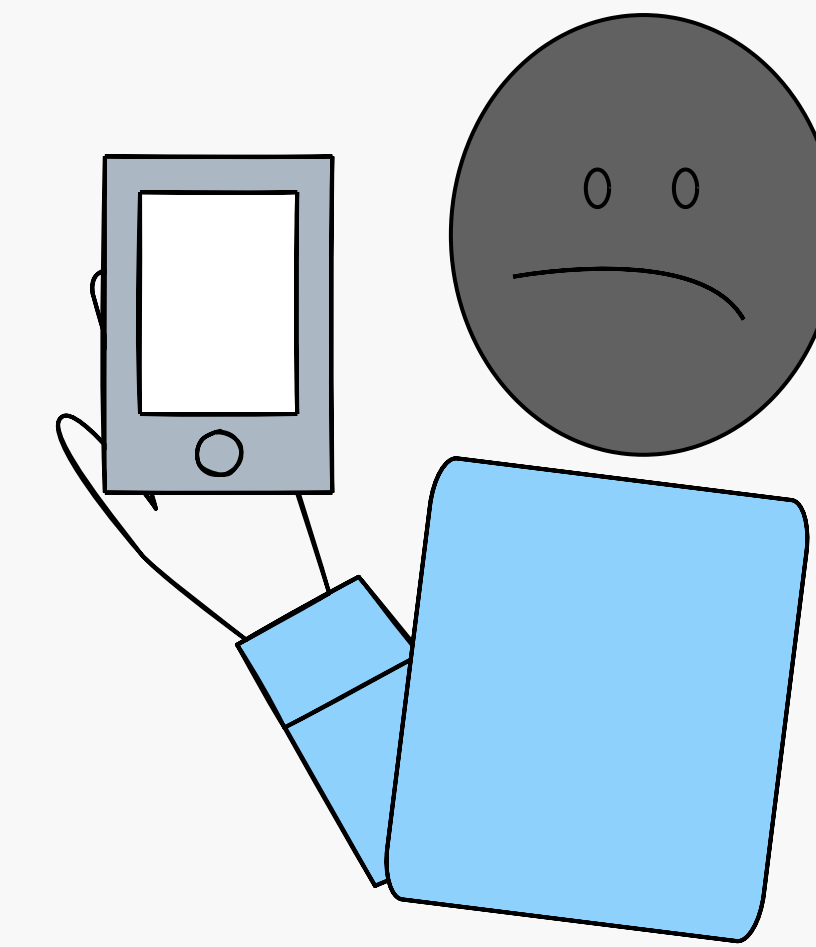
DO THESE:



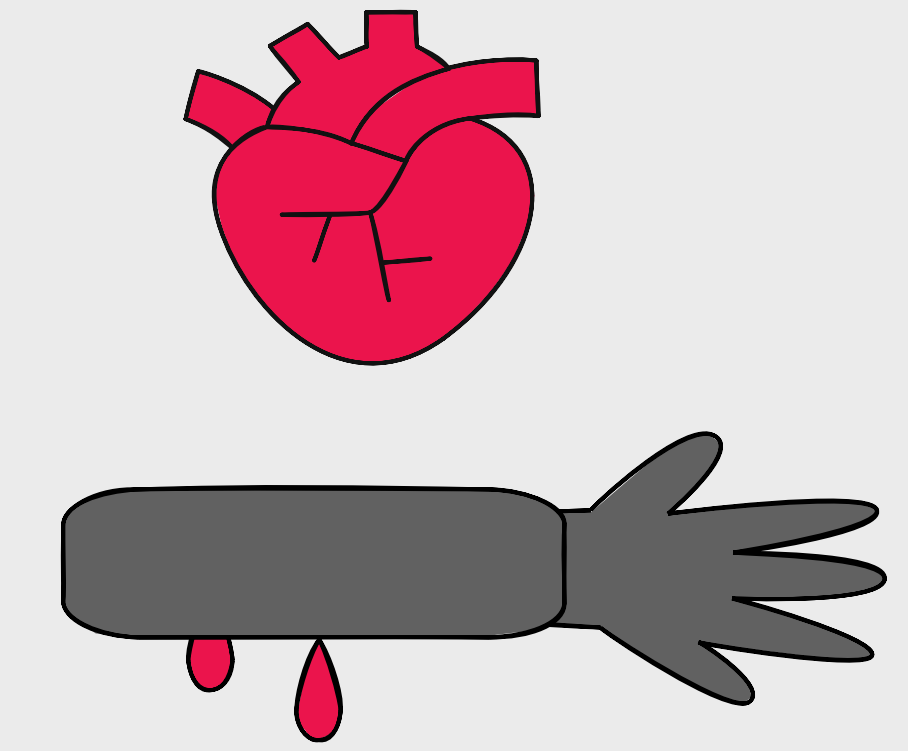
WALK away from the snake to a safe place



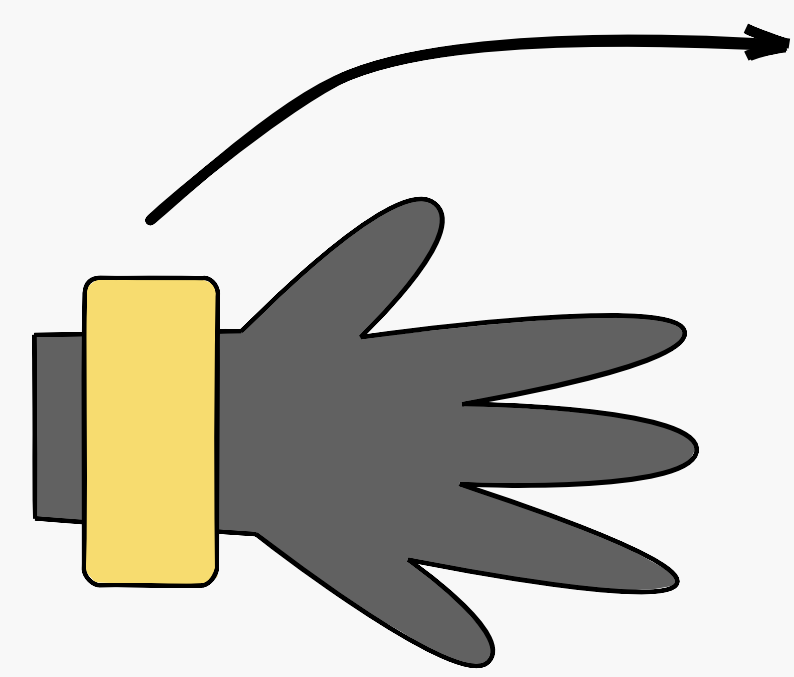
Stay as still as possible and remain calm to slow the spread of the venom



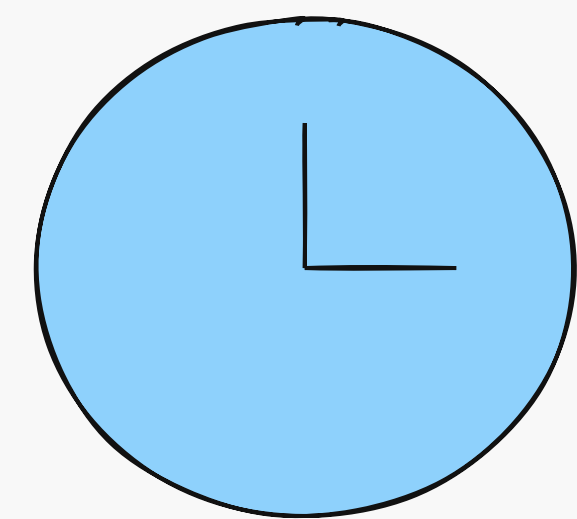
Call for help



Keep the wound below the heart



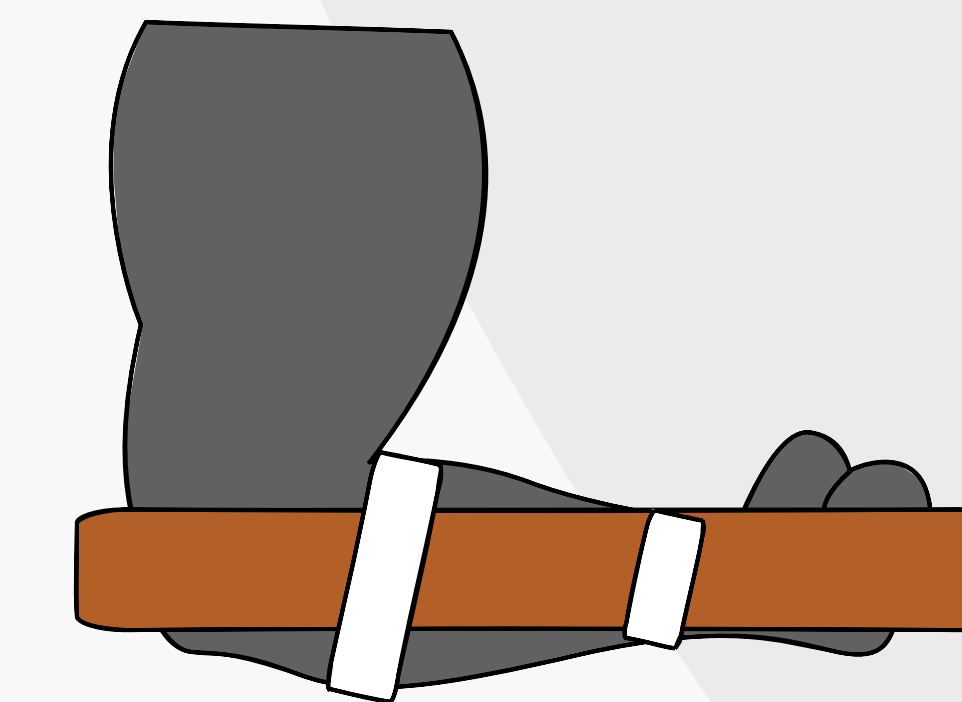
Remove jewelry and tight clothes



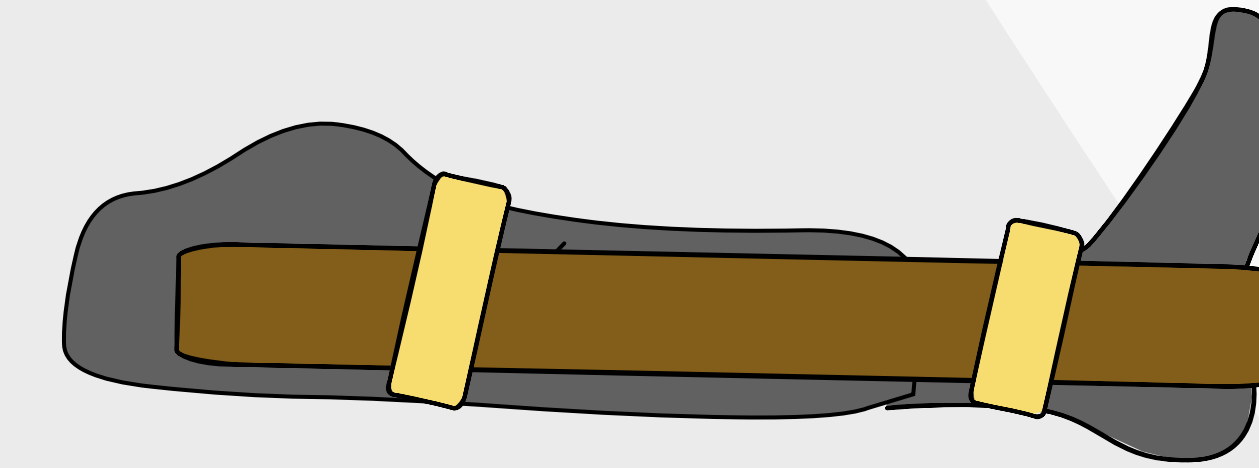
Record time of bite



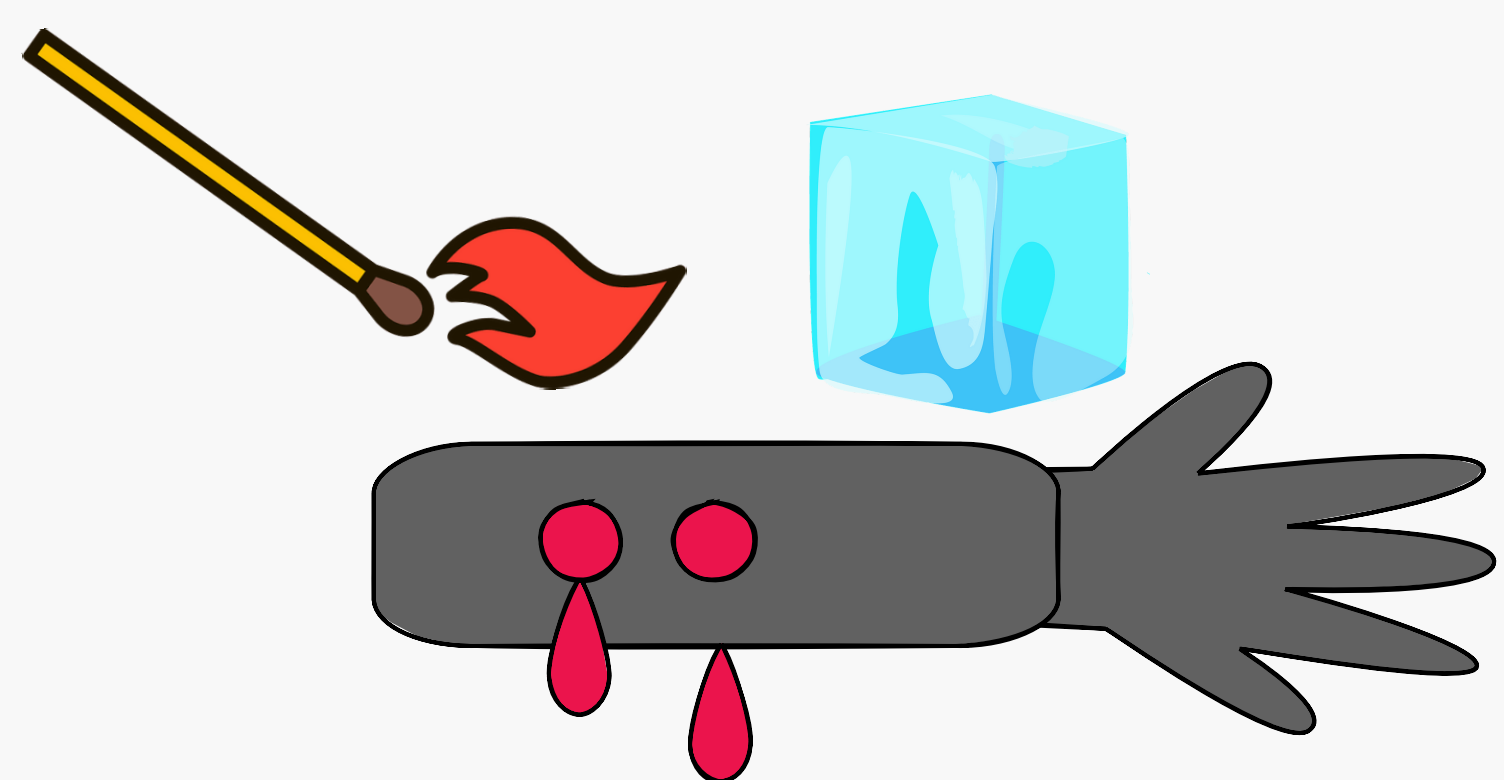
Drink water to avoid dehydration



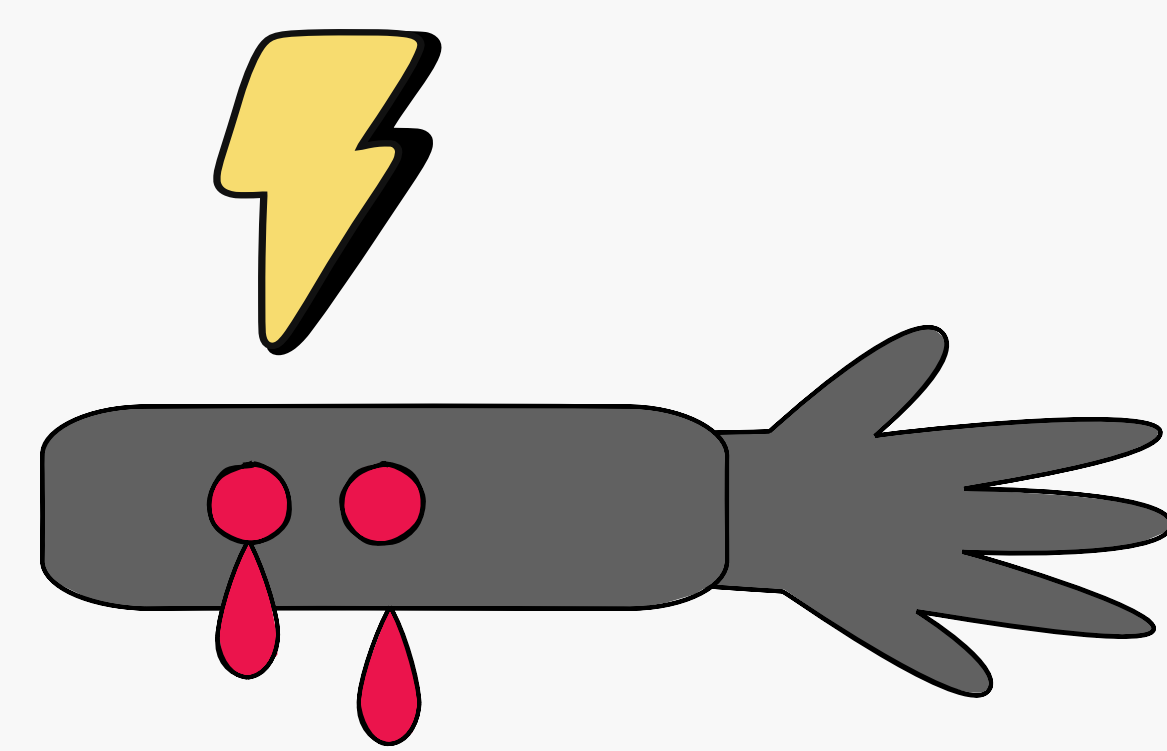
Immobilize the limb by making a splint



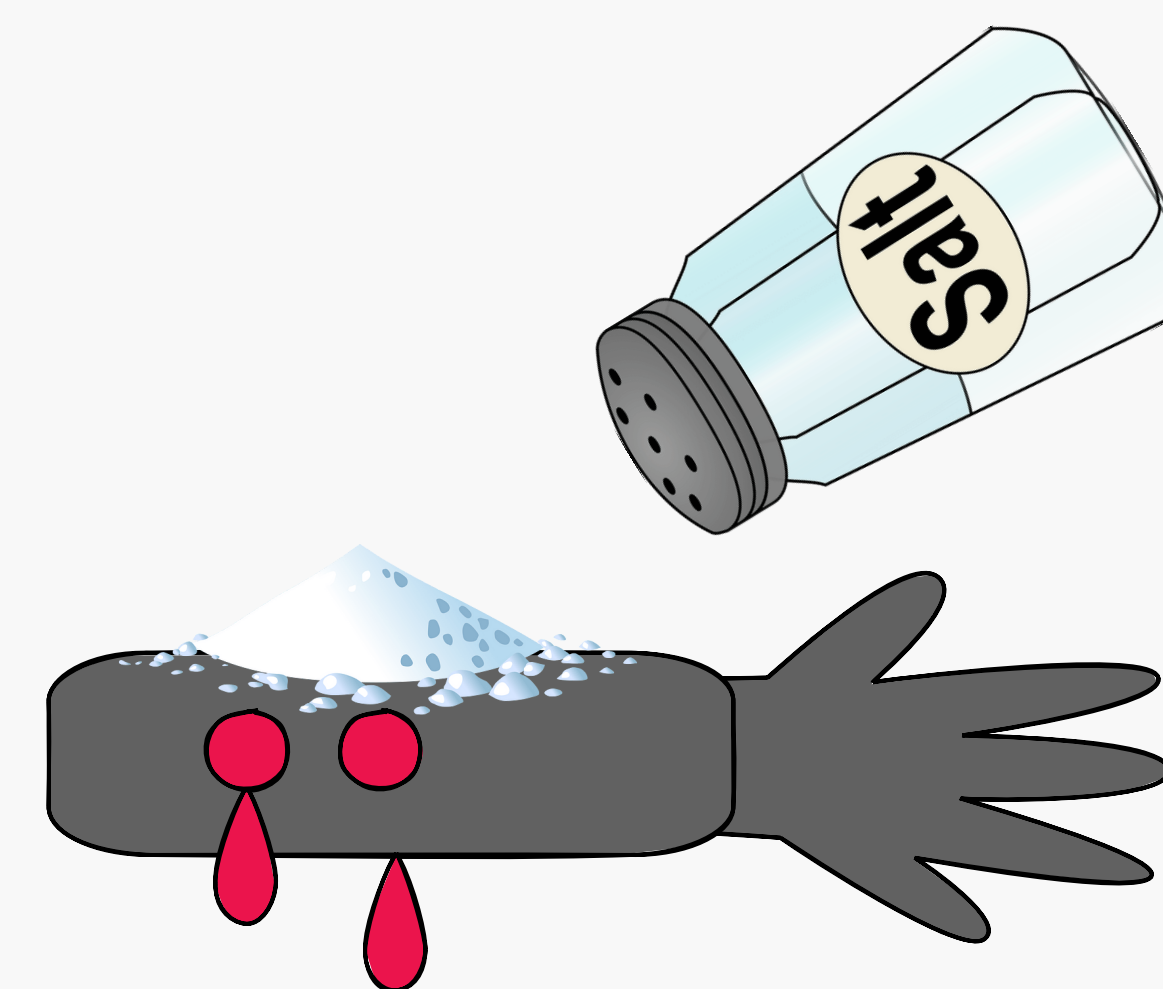
DON'T DO THESE:



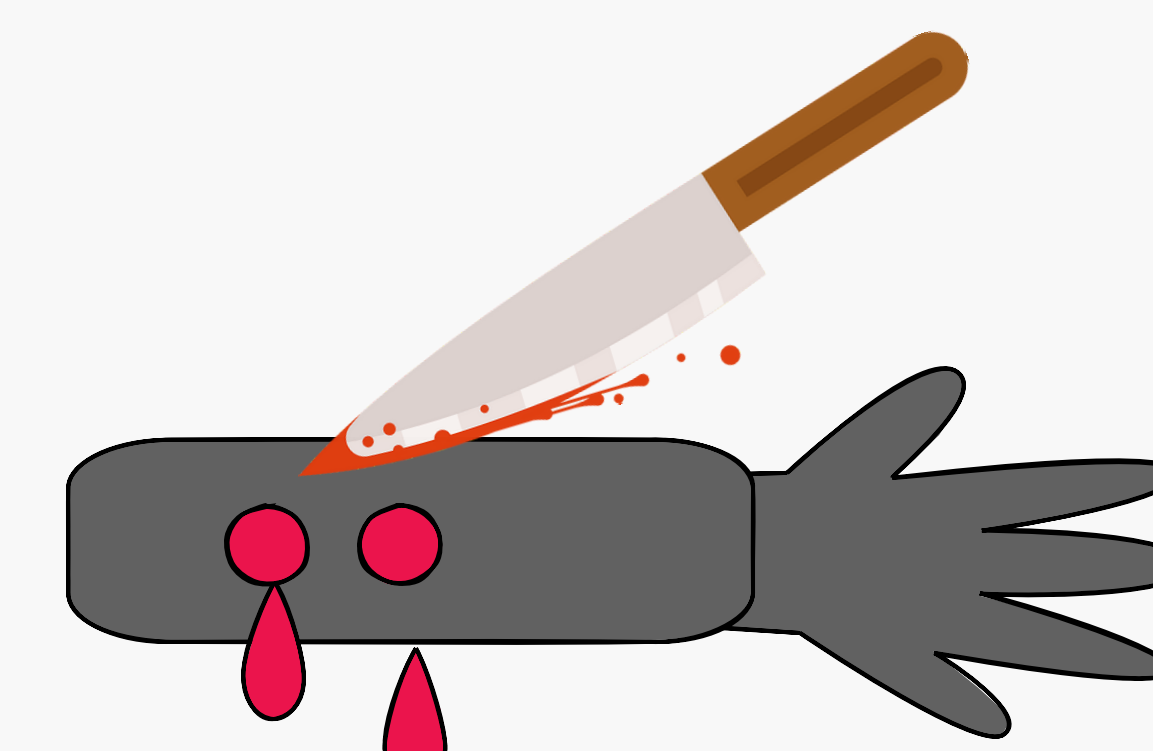
Do not burn or apply ice or cold



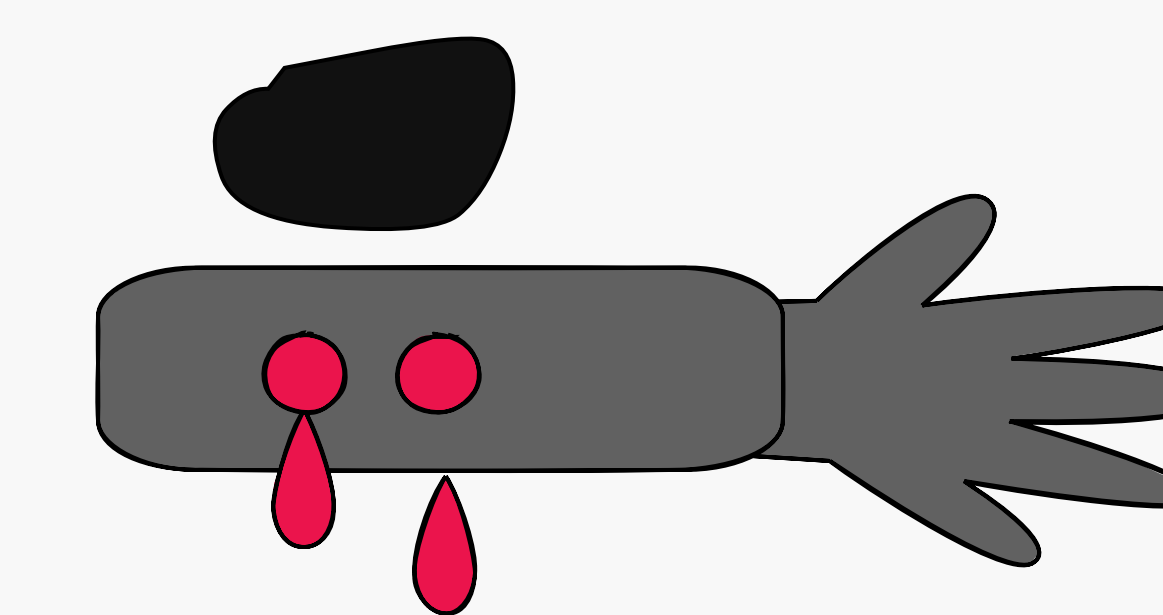
Do not shock



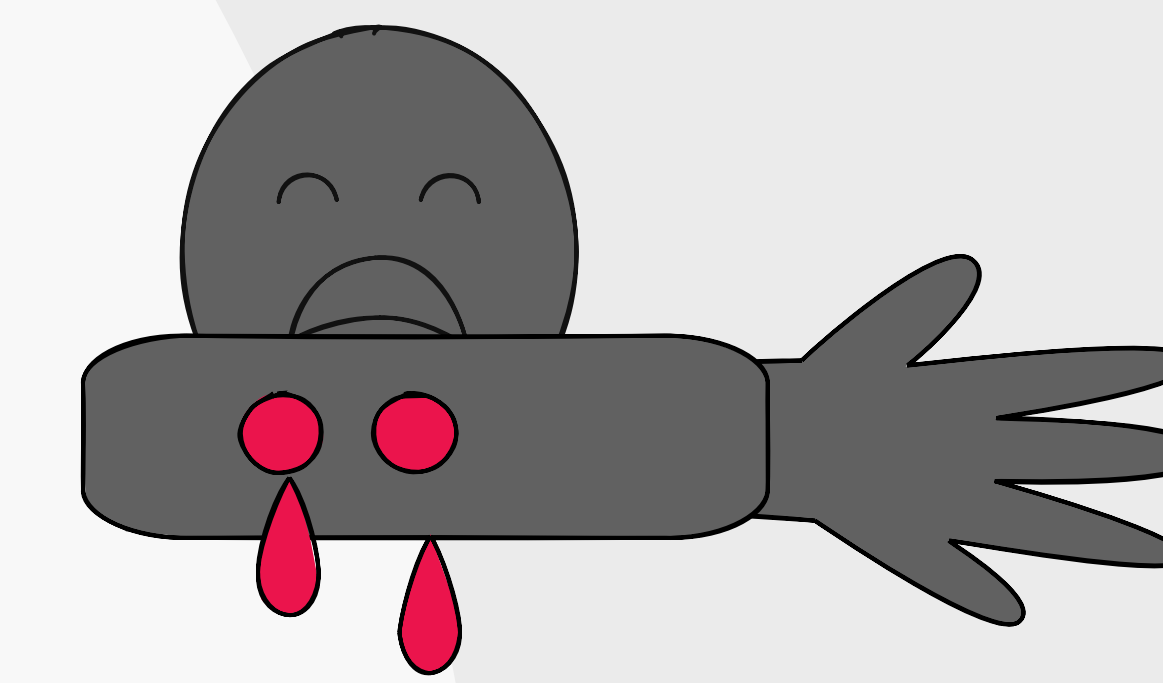
Do not add salt



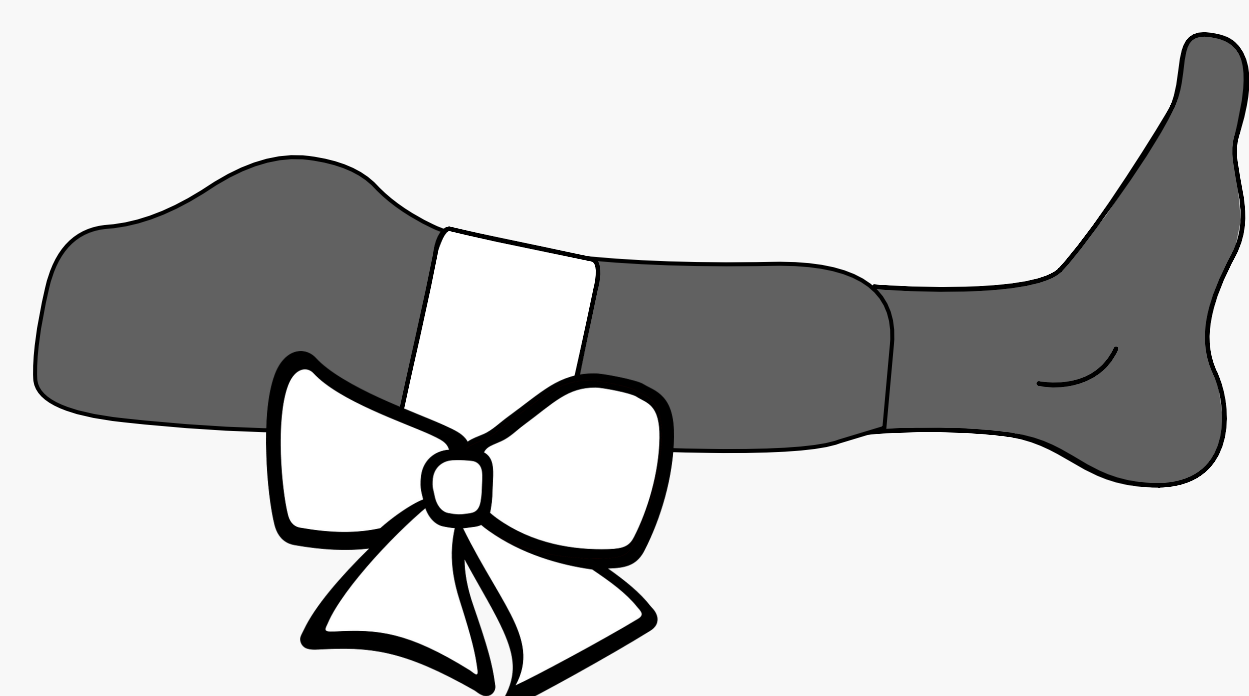
Do not cut



Do not use a black stone or charcoal



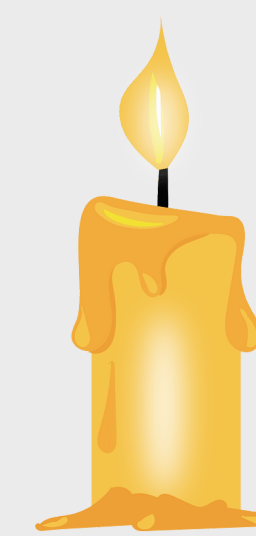
Do not try to suck out venom



No tourniquet



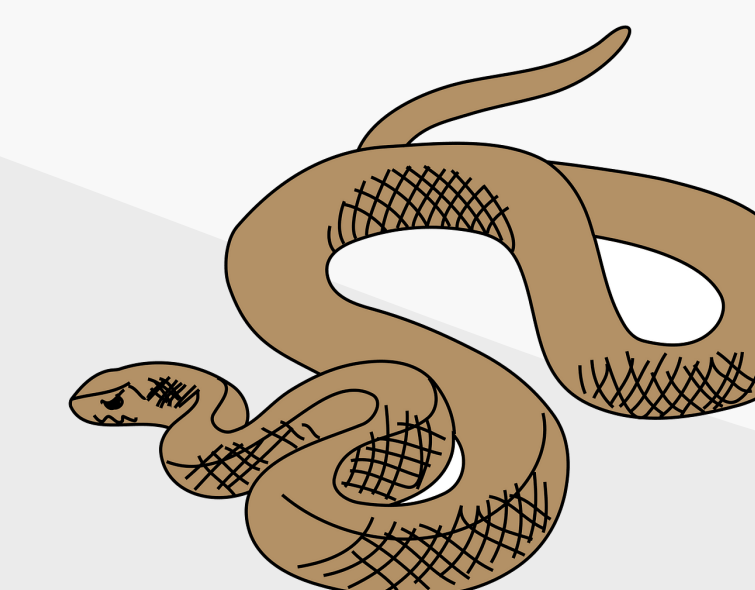
No traditional medicine
